Talented Oxford dancers, from toddlers to young adults, are presenting a day of dance in **Dancin' Oxford 2007**. A full day of performances will be taking place at **Pegasus Theatre on Saturday 3rd March**. **Dancing Chronicles** comprises three separate shows from **Tac-au-Tac Dance Theatre**.

Oxford is a city that buzzes with dance activity. There are classes and workshops happening all over the city every day of the week. **Joelle Pappas**, Director of Tac-au-Tac Dance Theatre is one of the growing ranks of local dance teachers who is also a performer and choreographer. Joelle has been established in Oxford for many years and is a renowned teacher and artist. Her choreography is often featured at the annual dance showcase events at Pegasus and her work with young people illustrates both her and their passion and creativity.

Dancing Chronicles is a celebration of youth dance in Oxford with the youngest members of Tac-au-Tac Dance Theatre performing with great confidence and ability beside their older counterparts. The three performances **Dawn Chorus**, **Fireside Tales** and **Impact** take us through a range of performances culminating in the very professional standard of **Oxford Youth Dance Company** presenting their latest repertoire choreographed by the company under the direction of choreographer **Claire Thompson**.
